- **Boilermakers 6000 hour program begins with safety and basic knowledge of industry training , online learning management system training, on the job training modules, and hands on training in our industry specialties at our training center.**

Boilermakers Workforce

- **Welding, rigging , and advanced mechanical work in heavy industrial steam generating systems and environmental control components for utility and industrial facilities.**
- **Repair maintenance and capital projects for all types of boilers and steam generating equipment including boiler tube installation and other boiler pressure parts.**
- **Installation of environmental modernization equipment such as pulse jet fabric filter houses, spray dry absorber, wet flue gas desulfurization scrubbers, dry scrubbers, electrostatic precipitators, selective catalytic reduction.**
- **tank design, fabrication, erection, maintenance and repair work for carbon, stainless steel, and fiberglass tanks and vessels. Assembling and field erection of all knocked down tanks. All completed tanks used for mixing, processing, or manufacturing when mixing or weighing two or more substances and all finished product completed tanks in manufacturing.**

West-Mec, Northland Pioneer College, Arizona Career Construction Days, RSI, San Juan Community College, AAI, Job Corps, and we have recruited from multiple high school welding programs.

Boilermakers Local 627 currently has 57 Apprentices and 35 Helpers and we graduate 15-20 Apprentices per year.
